Thought for the Week from S.A.D.D.: According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse, more than one in three drivers involved in fatal car crashes have blood alcohol content over the legal limit on St. Patrick's Day, making it one of the deadliest driving days of the year. The fatalities in 2016 represent nearly a 15 percent increase on average over the four previous years. From 2012-2016, 269 people were killed in crashes involving a drunk driver during the St. Patrick's Day holiday.
