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AP Exams Begin on Monday, May 1st

Room assignments: Testing Room Assignments will be posted outside of the Guidance Office. Room assignments will be updated with the change of rotating schedule. Please check the room assignment daily. If you have questions, please ask in the Guidance Office!

Morning AP Exams:

- For students taking a morning exam, please report to the testing room **at 7:35am.**
- Please be sure to eat prior to the exam as no food will be permitted in the testing room.
- If you miss your assigned Lunch period due to an exam, then you will be given the opportunity to eat in the next available lunch period.
- **Cell Phones will not be permitted in the testing room.**

Afternoon AP Exams:

- If you have an afternoon AP Exam, please plan on arriving to the testing room **at 11:35AM**
- If you miss your assigned Lunch period due to an exam, then you will be given the opportunity to eat in the available lunch period prior to testing (Period 5)
- **Cell Phones will not be permitted in the testing room.**

AP Testing Terms and Conditions: Students taking the AP exam will sign the *Terms and Conditions* on the day of the exam. You can access these Terms and Conditions online here:

Reminders:

- Students are expected to bring two #2 pencils, a pen with black or blue ink, and a valid photo ID.
- Cell Phones will **not be** permitted in the testing room.
- Students are to ensure their calculator is complaint with testing standards:

- Students are required to stay for the entire duration of the exam. No student will be excused from testing due to a conflict of any kind, including athletics. Students are expected to plan accordingly.
- If a student posts to any form of social media during the exam, or refers to unreleased exam content at any time after the exam, the student's score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and the student may be permanently banned from future testing
- Seniors will be able to send their AP test scores for free to their college of enrollment. There is a June 20th deadline for this submission. Students are to sign into My AP to indicate which college or university they'd like to receive their free score report.

Attendance: *Students taking the AP exam will be EXCUSED from classes the mornings prior to, or afternoons following their AP exams.*
