<u>ATTENTION ATHLETES - SPRING MEDICAL FORMS DUE TO NURSE BY FEB 12</u>

It's time to complete and submit your spring medical forms - **due FEB 12**. The official NJSIAA spring practice start dates are: March 10 - Boys Tennis, Baseball, & Softball (pitchers and catchers only)

March 13 - All other Spring Sports

Forms Due for Sports Participation:

- <u>Athlete Registration</u>: Athletes will be registering via Genesis this year. Please go to the <u>Genesis Parent</u> <u>Portal</u> → Login → Forms → Winter Sports Registration Form.
- <u>Health Updates</u>: Required for all athletes prior to the start of each season. *<u>Health History Update</u> <u>Questionnaire</u> (Found in Genesis)*
- **Sports Physicals**: Valid for 365 days and must be valid at the beginning of the sports season for participation. *Pre Participation Physical Evaluation Form (Click to download)*
- <u>Post Covid Clearance Form</u>: If an athlete has had Covid & not previously cleared by their doctor then they will need to be cleared. Also if a student gets Covid in between seasons, then once again they will need to be cleared. The District Doctor requires this.

All athletes must have a valid sports physical on file, an updated Health History update on file, be cleared by our District Doctor, and registered on Genesis <u>BEFORE</u> they can participate. Failure to have forms in on time may result in the inability to participate in tryouts, practices, or games.
