Please note the Ramapo Dress Code will be enforced:

- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- Students should wear clothing that fully covers all undergarments and all private areas. The majority of the torso should be covered.
- A student's face must be clearly identifiable at all times at the discretion of the RIH administration.
- Clothing with discriminatory, inappropriate, violent, or profane messages cannot be worn.
- Clothing may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, socioeconomic, or any other protected classification.
- Students are not permitted to wear clothing with pictures, emblems, or writing that is
  offensive or depicts any substance that students are prohibited from having or using at
  school.
- Religious and medical reasons will be reviewed by the administration and guided by federal and state laws.
- No restriction on student freedom of dress and adornment which are contrary to law and which might violate the rights of an individual student will be imposed.
